<b>Date</b>	Early 15th century
<b>Title</b>	Rashīd al-Dīn Ṭabīb, <i>Jāmi' al-Tavārīkh</i>
<b>Content</b>	A general history of the world by Rashīd al-Dīn Ṭabīb (1247?-1318) from the earliest times to AH 700 (1300/01), including a special account of the Mongols, brought down to AH 703 (1303/4). This copy was transcribed, according to a note on <a href="#">f. 403v</a> , for Sulṭān Shāhrukh (d. 1447) whose seal occurs in several places (for exampe on <a href="#">f. 623r</a> ). It also contains ( <a href="#">f. 410v</a> ) the handwriting of Shāh Rukh's third son Bāysunghur (1397-1433).

<b>Ownership</b>	Part of the library of Shāhrukh (d. 1447), and afterwards his son Muḥammad Sulṭān (d.855/1451). Acquired in 1825 from the estate of Claudius James Rich (1787-1821) who purchased it in Baghdad in April 1818.
