Title	Rashīd al-Dīn Ṭabīb, <i>Jāmi' al-Tavārīkh</i>
Content	A general history of the world by Rashīd al-Dīn Ṭabīb (1247?-1318) from the earliest times to AH 700 (1300/01), including a special account of the Mongols, brought down to AH 703 (1303/4). This copy was transcribed, according to a note on f. 403v , for Sulṭān Shāhrukh (d. 1447) whose seal occurs in several places (for example on f. 623r). It also contains (f. 410v) the handwriting of Shāh Rukh's third son Bāysunghur (1397-1433).

Ownership	Part of the library of Shāhrukh (d. 1447), and afterwards his grandson Muḥammad Sulṭān (d.855/1451). Acquired in 1825 from the estate of Claudius James Rich (1787-1821) who purchased it in Baghdad in April 1818.
