ISLAMIC SEALS

The British Library's Philatelic Collections hold ten Islamic metal seal matrices, of unknown provenance. Most appear to be Ottoman, and all but one are dated. They have been arranged in chronological order below. Three seals appear to have the initials or signatures of Ottoman seal engravers, two of which occur in the list of seal engravers' signatures published in M. Şinasi Acar, *Türk hat sanatı* = *Turkish calligraphy* (Istanbul: Antik A.Ş., 1999), pp. 290-295. These signatures are always written in much smaller letters than the main inscription, and are placed in {} brackets in the transliterations. The inscriptions are transliterated both in standard romanisation for Arabic and in modern Turkish orthography.

Islamic seal 1

Round, with a double-ruled outline, d. 14 mm; with a looped flat-topped handle, h. 23 mm.

'He who trusts [in God], the indigent ... Hasan'

Islamic seal 2

Round, with a double-ruled outline, d. 15 mm; central almond cartouche with double knots at each pointed end; handle with loop, h. 20 mm.

Wide oval, 11 x 15 mm; with a small knob handle with hole, h. 17 mm.

This appears to be the seal of a woman.




